Below are examples of a challenge and students projects. Note that these are just excerpts of students' projects which are originally part of a full presentation..

SDG 2: Zero Hunger (April, 2022)

Nearly 690 million people, or 8.9% of the world's population, suffer from malnutrition. The number of hungry people (calculated by the incidence of malnutrition) has been declining for decades, but has been slowly increasing since 2015. The number of people suffering from hunger has increased by 10 million in one year and by nearly 60 million in five years. At the current pace, more than 840 million people worldwide will be affected by hunger.

As future entrepreneurs, how can you contribute positively to society and support the cause of zero hunger as you also aim to achieve your business aspirations?
